#### JOB DESCRIPTION

- Teach and supervise occupational health and safety in current and future programs at the undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate levels
- Perform research and release publications on organizational dimensions of occupational health or safety and develop a competitive research program in the field
- Supervise students at all three academic levels (internships, intervention projects, master's and doctoral theses)
- Perform community services: contribute to department, school and university activities that promote community outreach

#### **REQUIREMENTS**

- PhD in administration, or equivalent, human resources management, public health, industrial relations, psychology, or related disciplines, with thesis or recent research on aspects of occupational health or safety
- Ability to teach occupational health and safety to students at all three academic levels, as evidenced by student evaluations
- Experience and research achievements in the field of occupational health or safety, as demonstrated by scientific publications and research grants
- Proven experience of the ability and skills to integrate into a multidisciplinary team and work collaboratively
- Fluent in French (spoken and written)\*

- Experience in workplace health and safety interventions also considered an asset
