## **Discussion Ground Rules**

Exercise/Activity Explanation (150 words or less):

Everyone should feel free to respectfully express their opinions, and to respectfully listen to the opinions of others. Participants should read the Discussion Ground Rules at the beginning of an ethics discussion and agree to abide by them. Have a different person read each Ground Rule. The group leader should intervene the moment a participant violates a ground rule. Ask participants which ground rule has been violated, and have everyone read each ground rule again.
