The webinar looks among various types of (im)migrants as it illuminates diverse critical perspectives on the 'business of (im)migration.' As the migrant embodies the 'nomadic-way-of-life', characterized by a constant movement resisting the motionless boundaries of the "State", convenors and speakers self-reflect about themselves as *nomadic* researchers/ethnographers.

The conversation aims to connect with the broader debate around discourses of (anti)globalization, nationalism, and development.
